### Document A

A. 1. Who are the characters? Say if they are present or simply mentioned.

**The characters are: Tia, Mike, Brett (all present) and Adam (only mentioned).**

2. How are they related?

**Mike and Tia: Adam's parents. Brett: installing software on Adam's computer.**

B. What is LIVE SPY and what is it designed for? Explain in one sentence.

**Software => to record and report everything someone does on a computer.**

C. 1. Who in the text is going to use LIVE SPY?

**Tia and Mike / Adam's parents**

2. Who is going to be watched by LIVE SPY?

**Adam**

D. In this particular case, what is the reason for using LIVE SPY? Pick out at least three reasons.

- 1.13: *"he quit"*; 1.14: *"Adam laid down the stick and pads and mask and said he was done."*

- 1.16: *"his decline"* / *"his withdrawal"*; 1.21: *"Adam was moody and quiet"*; 1. 21-22 *"He spent all his time in this room, mostly on this wretched computer, playing fantasy games or instant-messaging"*; 1.23-24: *"He barely spoke to them, responding rarely, and when he did, with grunts."*

- 1.20: *"We are losing him"*

**uses a GPS to be located / 5 times a day**

H. What is the reason why he had to change his daily routine? Use your own words and quote two elements from the text to justify your answer.

**Because he had trouble going to school**

- Title: "*truants*"
- l.9: "*truancy*"
- l.11: "*skip classes*"
- l.15: "*have trouble getting to class every day*"

I. Is Ryan Ramos the only child in this case? Quote the text to justify your answer.

**No, he isn't. l.8: "*Ramos and 31 other students (in the Anaheim Union High School District are participating voluntarily)*"**

J. 1. Quote at least three arguments given by the supporters of the new system and two arguments given by its opponents.

**Supporters:**

- l.9: "*cutting-edge solution to the age-old problem of truancy*"
- l.10-11: "*giving parents and school officials a better idea of where students are*"
- l.11: "*giving students a visible incentive to resist peer pressure to skip classes*"
- l.12-13: "*succeed where curfews, strict punishments and even fines for parents have failed*"
- l.19: "*helps students attend more classes and do better in school*"
- l.20: "*the program combines the GPS device with human interaction*"



**Opponents**

- 1.14: *"the Big Brother aspects of satellite monitoring"*
- 1.15: *"it's a criminalization of kids"*
- 1.18: *"concerns about privacy"*
